As we navigate this time of home learning for our students, we would like to share the Meta-Play Curriculum with you. Meta-Play is a play-based curriculum for students with autism and other developmental delays and/or disabilities that focuses on developing their imagination and social awareness skills.

Your student has been using Meta-Play in their classroom this school year, and this packet will give you all of the information you need to continue their Meta-Play work in the home environment.

At the beginning of the packet is a brief introduction to the Meta-Play Curriculum, as well as some ideas on how to support your students as you work through the lessons, such as how to prompt them when they are struggling or how much time to spend on each task.

After the introductory information are the lesson plans. The lesson plans are brief and user-friendly. They include the objective (or purpose) of the lesson, any common household materials you may need, and a description of how to do the lesson. Remember, all of the lessons are play-based – so if it feels like you’re just playing with your child, you’re doing it right!

This time of remote learning is new to many of us, and we appreciate your continued support and collaboration as we work to provide you and your student with the tools, information, and support you need to continue working on school-based tasks in the home environment.
