Dear Guardian,

I am excited for your child to begin using *TeachTown SLP Assist* at home! *SLP Assist* was built to provide a solution to school-based SLP's need to provide speech and language services through an integrated platform for students. It uses prompting, modeling, reinforcement, discrete trial training, computer-based lessons, SLP delivered speech and language lessons, and visual support to teach a range of skills in morphology, semantics, syntax, articulation, decoding, phonological and phonemic awareness, and social communication

How to Access the *TeachTown SLP Assist* Program

Windows/Mac/Chromebook - Computers	iPad Application
Navigate to www.teachtown.com/login via Chrome and have your child log in using their username and password.	Via the Apple App Store, search for <i>TeachTown SLP Assist Student</i> , and download the application. Have your child log in using their username and password

Starting a Session

Once your child has logged in, they will be able to start a session by following the steps below:

1. If prompted, select 'SLP Assist.'

• You will not have to make this selection on the iPad app.

2. Click the 'play' icon.



3. The session will run for the amount of time that the therapist assigned.



Allow Your Child to Work on Their Own

Once you see the domain icons on the screen, your child's session has begun. **Do not help your child select answers**. TeachTown will automatically help your child if he or she is having difficulty with a concept. **Do not repeat the computer's instructions** for your child. TeachTown is teaching your child to follow instructions after hearing them once, even in a noisy environment. If you help your child, TeachTown will not know that you are helping and will not help your child appropriately or advance your child in the curriculum appropriately.

Ending a Session

Your child's session will end automatically after your child works in the program for the amount of time assigned by their SLP.
