

# TeachTown Transition to Adulthood at Home Use

Dear Guardian,

I am excited for your child to begin using *TeachTown Transition to Adulthood* at home! Transition to Adulthood was built around evidence-based practices to meet the needs of individuals with autism spectrum disorder, intellectual disabilities and developmental disabilities. It uses point-of-view modeling, task analyses, computer-based lessons, teacher-delivered lessons and visual support to teach a range or critical, functional skills in the areas of: Personal Life skills, Home Skills, Vocational Skills, Community Skills and Leisure Skills and contains an online assessment tool for progress monitoring.

# How to Access the TeachTown Transition to Adulthood Program

<u> Windows/Mac/Chromebook – Computers</u>	IPad Application
Navigate to <u>www.teachtown.com/login</u> via Chrome and have your child log in using their username and password.	Via the Apple App Store, search for <i>TeachTown</i> <i>Transition,</i> and download the application. Have your child log in using their username and password

## **Starting a Session**

Or	nce your child has logged in, they will be able to	start a session by following the steps below:
1.	If prompted, select 'Transition to Adulthood' (You will not have to make this selection on the iPad app)	Transition to Adulthood
2.	Click the 'play' icon	Start Your Session
3.	The session will run for the amount of time that the teacher assigned. The session will always start with the selection screen shown here:	



### Allow Your Child to Work on Their Own

Once you see the domain icons on the screen, your child's session has begun. **Do not help your child select answers**. TeachTown will automatically help your child if he or she is having difficulty with a concept. **Do not repeat the computer's instructions** for your child. TeachTown is teaching your child to follow instructions after hearing them once, even in a noisy environment. If you help your child, TeachTown will not know that you are helping and will not help your child appropriately or advance your child in the curriculum appropriately.

### **Ending a Session**

Your child's session will end automatically after your child works in the program for the amount of time assigned by the teacher.
