


Teacher Instructions for Transition to Adulthood Student Login Setup

Now that you are ready to have your student use the computer based lessons in *TeachTown Transition to Adulthood* independently, here are a few steps to follow:

Create a Student Login and Password for your student(s):

- 1. Log into your TeachTown Account
- 2. Select 'Transition to Adulthood'
- 3. At the bottom of the page, select 'Manage' and then 'Manage My Students'




4. Select 'Manage Credentials for My Students'



5. Make sure the box next to the student name in the 'enabled' column is checked, then click on the pencil icon.



6. Assign the Student a username and password, then click the save icon



*A username must be a minimum of 3 characters long, and it must be different than all other usernames in the TeachTown system

**Passwords must be 6-20 characters, and must contain a capital letter, a lowercase letter, and a number


7. Repeat for each student

Set the Session Length for Each Student:


- 1. Log into your TeachTown Account
- 2. Select 'Transition to Adulthood'
- 3. At the bottom of the page, select 'Manage' and then 'Manage My Students'




4. Select 'Manage Session Length Settings'



5. Choose the session duration, and the student(s) you want to make a change to



6. Select 'Update Selected Students'



*The default session length is 25 minutes
